


DAY 3

The Lord says, “I will guide you along the best pathway for your life. I will advise you and watch over you.

Psalm 32:8 NLT

If you’ve ever gone for a hike, then you know how important a map is. If you don’t have something to guide you as you go, you can end up lost pretty quickly! The same is true in life.
